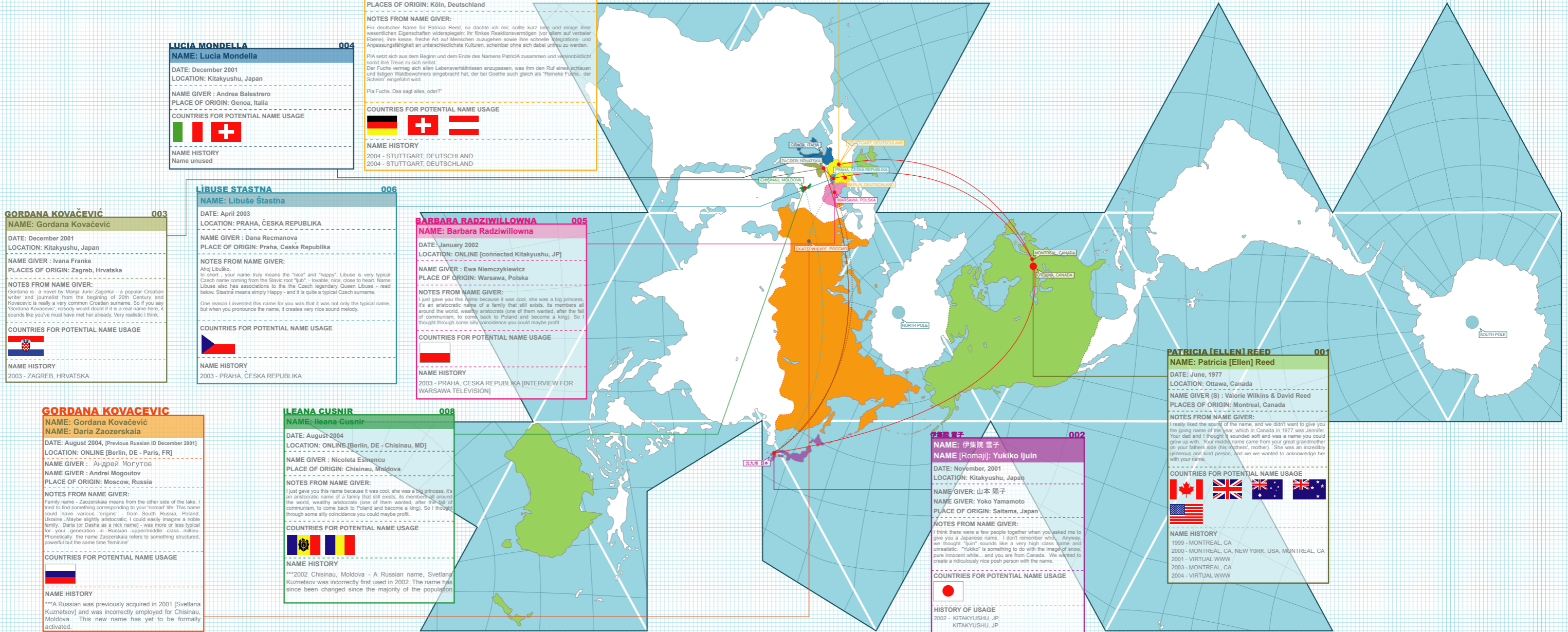

RULES OF NAME GIVING

- NAMES ARE SELECTED BY A NATIVE CITIZEN FROM THE TERRITORY IN QUESTION
- NAMES ARE GIVEN AFTER A PERIOD OF ACQUAINTANCESHIP
- WHEN NAMES ARE REQUESTED, THEY CANNOT BE REFUSED OR NEGOTIATED
- NAMES CAN BE USED FOR OTHER NATIONAL TERRITORIES BASED ON LANGUAGE SIMILARITIES [EX. PIA FUCHS AS A GERMAN NAME CAN ALSO BE USED IN AUSTRIA]

NAME NOTATION

- NAMES ARE NOT AN ALIAS, NOR A DEVICE USED TO HIDE THE ORIGINAL AUTHORS NAME, THEY ARE AN EXTENSION OF AN ORIGINAL IDENTITY.

NAMES MUST BE NOTATED AS SUCH:

PIA FUCHS, DEUTSCHER IDENTITÄT VON PATRICIA REED

NAME USAGE

- IN THE CASE OF PHYSICAL DISPLACEMENT, THE CORRESPONDING NAME FOR THE REGION IS EMPLOYED. IT IS PUBLICLY NOTATED AS INDICATED IN NAME NOTATION*
- IN THE CASE OF VIDEO PRODUCTION, WHERE OFTEN THE SUBSEQUENT DISSEMINATION IS NON-PHYSICAL [NO PERSONAL DISPLACEMENT - OBJECT DISPLACEMENT BY POST ONLY], THE AUTHORSHIP IS ATTRIBUTED TO THE REGION OF PRODUCTION OF THE VIDEO.
ex. a video produced in Croatia and screened at a festival in Canada, without physically being present would read: Gordana Kovačević, Croatian Identity of Patricia Reed
- IN THE CASE OF VIRTUAL WORK [WEB BASED PRODUCTION] THE ORIGINAL IDENTITY IS USED, THIS IS CONSISTENTLY PATRICIA REED.
- IN THE CASE OF VIDEO SCREENING WITH A PHYSICAL PRESENCE ON THE SITE OF DISPLAY, THE THREE CORRESPONDING IDENTITIES ARE USED:
ex. a video produced in Germany and screened at a festival in Moldova, with physical presence would read: A video by Ileana Cusnir as Pia Fuchs, Moldavian and German Identities of Patricia Reed
